

About library



- The Library of the University of Opole is the greatest library in Opole voivodship.
- It supports university employees and students in their academic and didactic work.
- The Library network consists of 11 specialist libraries, and their resources correspond with educational profiles of the faculties and institutes.
- The Library offers access to both printed and electronic versions of books and periodicals.
- Thanks to the library catalog it is possible to search and order books via the Internet as well as to check the status of your library account.
- Students and employees are able to use electronic resources outside the University by means of HAN specialist system.
- The Library is the member of Silesia Digital Library, making the valuable publications from its resources available free of charge for the Internet users.
- The Main Library owns 649 old prints coming from Polish and European publishing houses from 16th-18th centuries, and a collection of manuscripts from 19th and 20th centuries.

How to join the library?

- Please go to the library, submit a completed declaration containing personal data and sign the obligation to comply with the Library Regulations, and in addition, present:
- ID card or other evidence of identity and current student ID card.


How many books can be borrowed?



- View full search results. (Some databases, only show results when you're signed in.)



How to check if the book is available to be borrowed?

- In the search results list click on the link choosing source of the Main Library or specialist libraries.
- In the description of the individual units attention should be paid to the **Item status**.
- be ordered. If next to the book the date of return of the copy appears, it means that it is on loan! Information On shelf indicates that the book can be ordered by clicking on the option Hold, which is located to the right of the individual units, after required logging into the library system
- Information about the location of the book will appear at **Pickup** location. Then click **Send request**. The green bar will show a message about accepting the order.





Within how many days should I pick up an ordered book?

- Otherwise, the library account will be blocked.








Direct link to the text of the electronic book in the database







How to log in to my account?

- You can access your account in 3 ways:
 - by clicking **Sign in**
 - by clicking My Library Card in Menu
 - by clicking My account
- In the field **Card Number**:
 - type correctly your student ID card number which is located below the bar code or "Nr albumu".
- ▶ In the field **Password**:
 - Readers who do not have a password, repeat the above card number.





Why can not I order a book?


- Card number or password was entered incorrectly
- Your library account is blocked due to retention of books
- If the account is blocked, the system will display information about the cause on **My Library Card** (Blocks+messages). If you are in doubt, ask a librarian.



Is it possible to prolong the book borrowed? Where and how to do it?

The loan period of the book can be extended for one month, but you must do so before the deadline for its return. This can be done in person at the library or by catalog, by phone or email.





What to do in case of lost books?

- In the event of damage or loss of a book you should report it in the library, and then:
- Provide the same book, and if there is no such opportunity, pay a compensation of the book according to the rules determined by the Rector of the UO.




What happens when a book is not returned on time?

▶ In the case of non-compliance with the book return date, the computer automatically locks the account and charges readers monetary fee as determined by the Rector of the UO price list of 0,20 zł per day (short-term loan – 2 zł per day). The account will be unlocked after paying the penalty fee and returning books.

What do I need to do to use the collection in the Reading Room?

- Books and periodicals are located directly in the Reading Room, where there is open access to the shelves, or in the storehouse.
- After verifying signatures in the computer catalog, you should go to reading room, where you simply present a student ID card.



Access to electronic databases

- via computers which belong to the UO network
- Find a selected database on the UO Main Library website ("Electronic sources" tab ►"Databases" ► databases' names table).
- 2. Click the name of the database.
- via computers which do not belong to the UO network

("private computers")

- Find selected database on the UO Main Library website ("Electronic sources" tab ▶"Databases" ▶ databases' names table).
- 2. Click the icon and login field to the HAN system will appear. You need to type your personal number of a student ID card and the password to your library account.





Please note that only employees and students of the University of Opole can access electronic databases from private computers. Other library users can access these resources through the UO network.




Principles concerning the access and use of the University of Opole electronic resources

- I. It is allowed to make a copy of single article and a book's part on electric carrier or to print it for didactic purposes or scientific research only.
- ▶ 2. It is forbidden to create multiple copies of the articles, periodicals and electronic books and to store them without necessity if it is not required by current research.
- ▶ 3. It is forbidden to publish the articles or electronic books' fragments and to reprint them in original or alternated form, with the omission of the source and copyrights' specification.
- ▶ 4. It is forbidden to make use of licensed electronic stocks of the University of Opole Library for commercial activity (other than scientific).
